Description

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Learning objectives:

On completion of the training, participants will be able to:

- Understand the basics of dangerous goods
- Know the rules for classifying dangerous goods
- Know the rules for preparing dangerous goods shipments
- Know the rules for processing and accepting cargo

This training and its assessment have been developed using the Competency Based Approach (CBTA). See IATA guide on "Dangerous goods training guidance".

Teaching methods: Interactive e-learning training session with sound. Formative assessment exercises at the end of the sequence. Training materials available to download online. Remote, asynchronous tutoring is provided by e-mail in the event of particular learning difficulties via the "Contact us" form.

Target audience: Shippers

Prerequisites: A good understanding of English

Exam conditions

Final test: The final test takes the form of an unsupervised online questionnaire. The minimum pass rate is 80% correct answers.

Failed test:

- If the rate is between 60% and 80%, the participant may revise all or part of the training and take the assessment again.
- If the rate is less than 60%, the participant will have to be re-registered and take the full training again.

Certification

Certification: If participants pass the final test, they will be issued with an electronic certificate.
